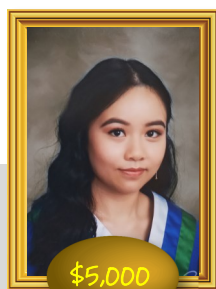

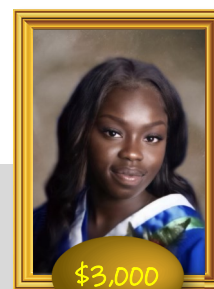

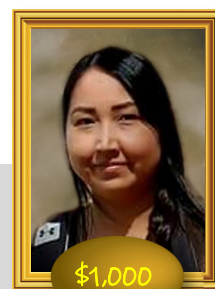

- To advance education by running after school and summer homework clubs for youth in Edmonton.

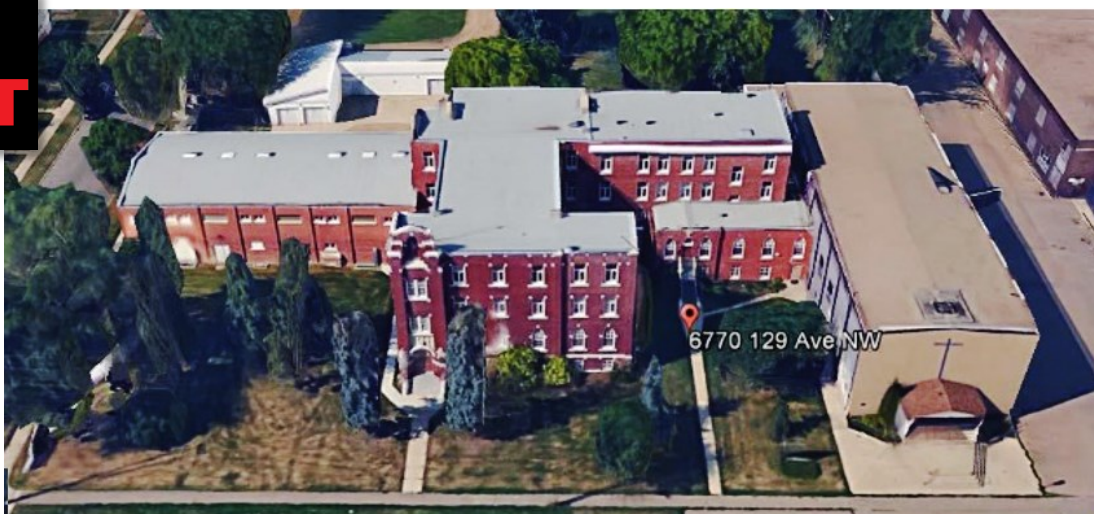
- Relieve poverty by operating summer camps in Edmonton for youth from low-income families.

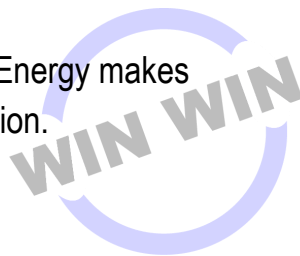
